RULES SHEET

- 1. The competition is individual match play format, with the low handicap playing at zero and the challenger playing at 80% of the difference in handicap. Calculations ending in 0 to point 4 (.4) will be rounded down, calculations ending in point 5 (.5) to point 9 (.9) will be rounded up. Examples: handicap of 3.3 becomes a 3 handicap, and a handicap of 3.5 becomes a 4 handicap.**
- 2. All matches to be played from the white tees. All match play rules are to be followed and enforced during play.**
- 3. All members must be members of Garrison Golf and Curling Club.**
- 4. Handicaps will be current with scores from all previous rounds recorded in the handicap computer prior to the day's match. Failure to do so will result in a review by the convener and possible forfeiture of the win. SAND BAGGING WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- 5. It is the responsibility of the player in the top bracket to contact the player in the bottom bracket to arrange the match. Matches not played with the time allocated will result in the player in the top bracket advancing. Certain situations may require an executive member to make a ruling to advance one of the players. If after two unsuccessful attempts by either player to arrange a match, the offending player does not show or is unavailable he will forfeit the match and the other player will advance.**
- 6. In the event of a tie the match is to be continued on a sudden death format with handicap strokes given as they appear on the card. The Proshop will decide which side will be used to continue play in order to maintain control of the course. If darkness or severe weather conditions (lightning) prevent continuations of the match at that time you will arrange to complete the match within the allocated time.**
- 7. When in doubt as to procedure, play a provisional ball, record both scores and seek a ruling immediately after play. Questions are to be directed to Rob Lloyd if unavailable, any employee of Garrison may make a ruling on his behalf. All rulings are based on the rules of golf.**
- 8. Good luck and play well.**
