Frost Delay

Purpose

The purpose of this document is to outline the Garrison Golf and Curling Club's (GG&CC) policy regarding delays due to Frost

Intent

It is the intent of the Golf Executive committee to ensure that a policy is in place that will provide clear direction for the staff so that they can perform their duties while still allowing for the maximum possible golfing pleasure for members and patrons of the GG&CC.

Application

In the event of a frost delay the following procedures will be implemented. Normal Start (Tee times off of one nine only)

Tee times will be delayed up to 1 hour. If the delay continues beyond 1 hour, tee times will be forfeited every 7/8 minutes.

For example: If the first tee time is 7:00 AM and there is a frost delay that last over 1 hour at 8:07 AM the group that was supposed to tee off at 7:00 AM will forfeit their tee time. If the delay continues, at 8:15 AM the group that was supposed to tee off at 7:07 will forfeit their tee time. Crossover Start (Tee Times off of both nines at the same time)

Tee times will be delayed up to ½ hour. If the delay continues beyond ½ hour, tee times will be forfeited every 7/8 minutes. For example: If the first tee times are at 7:00 AM and there is a frost delay that last over ½ hour, at 7:37 AM the groups that were supposed to tee off at 7:00 AM will forfeit their tee times. If the delay continues, at 7:45 AM the groups that were supposed to tee off at 7:07 will forfeit their tee times.

Dress Policy

General

Dress for all members, guests and patrons utilizing the facilities of the GG&CC shall meet a minimum acceptable standard of attire. The dress regulations apply throughout the year. The starter, course officials and G&CC staff will refuse play or service to anyone contravening the dress regulations.

Prohibited Dress

The following are classed as unacceptable attire for GG&CC facilities:

1. Jeans or jean shorts of any type or colour (clean jeans are permitted in the Clubhouse, but not on the golf course).
2. Sweat pants, spandex pants, stirrup pants, cut-off pants, swim suits or short shorts
3. Shirts with slogans or numbers, such as hockey or football jerseys.
4. Tank tops, singlets (undershirt T-shirts), halter tops, or shirts without some type of collar (turtlenecks and mock turtlenecks are fine).
5. No shirt.
6. Footwear with metal spikes, soccer or football type cleats, or have a design that would cause damage to the golf course.
7. Military uniforms, or portions thereof, are not to be worn, by golfers, on the golf course

No Show Policy

Definition

A "No Show" is:

1. A person or persons not arriving for their pre-booked tee time and not calling 12 hours in advance to cancel, either by removing their name by way of the reservation system or calling the Pro Shop/Starter.
2. A person knowingly booking players into a group that are not aware or have no intention of playing, and the names are not removed 24 hours in advance of the tee time by either calling the reservation system or contacting the Pro Shop/Starter.
3. Any member or military booking a guest(s) and not canceling their guest(s) before arriving for their scheduled tee time.

Factors Affecting No Shows

4. A no show will not be registered against a member or registered military daily fee player if weather conditions are adverse. Adverse weather conditions can include cold, rain, frost or snow.
5. Members and military daily fee players shall not receive a no show incases of illness or family emergency.

Administrative & Disciplinary Steps

Members and Military daily fee players:

6. All members and military daily fee players shall receive a complimentary no show. This no show will be accounted for in the reservation system but no action will be taken.
7. Upon the second no show, a member or military daily fee player shall receive written notice that they are on probation and will lose their playing privileges for a period of two weeks in case of another infraction.
8. Upon the third infraction, playing privileges will be suspended immediately for a two week period and written notice forwarded.
9. Continued infractions may result in termination of membership or in the case of a military daily fee player, access to the facility. This step can only be taken in minute action by the full golf committee.

Guest No Shows:

10. All members and military daily fee players shall receive a complimentary guest no show. This no show will be accounted for in the reservation system but no action will be taken.
11. Upon the second no show, a member or military daily fee player shall receive written notice that they are on probation and will be obliged to pay a full 18 hole non military green fee for future guest no shows
12. Continued infractions will result in the requirement of full payment in advance for a guest booking. No refund will be offered if the guests are unable to make the scheduled tee time.
